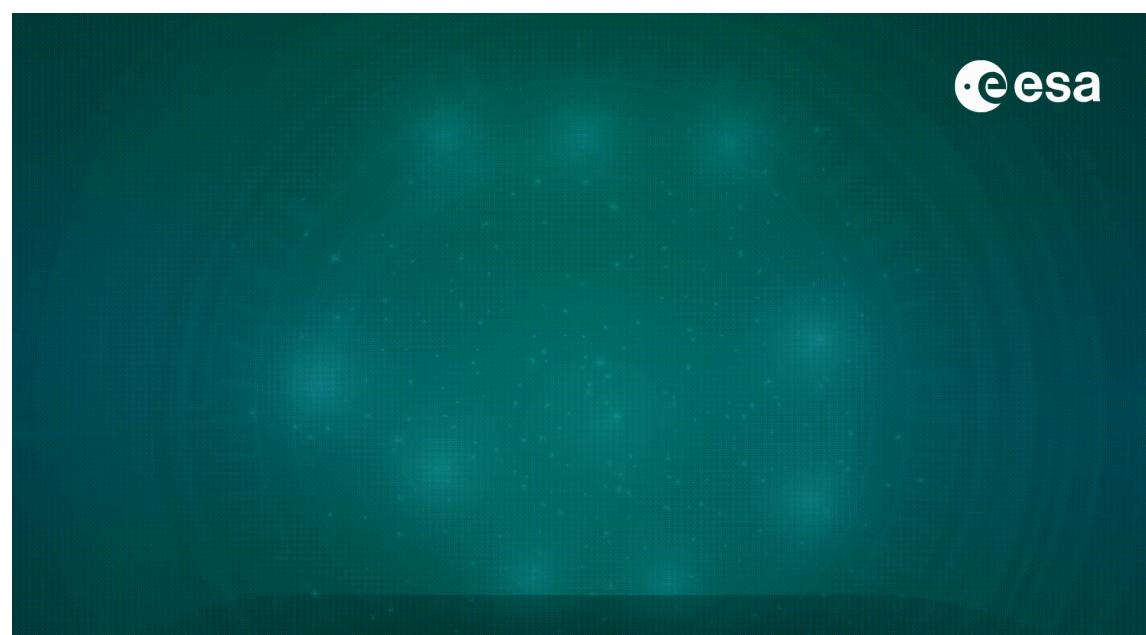
Did you know?

These recordings provide valuable opportunities to explore EO cloud platforms and learn how to effectively access and exploit EO data.

Highlights from previous webinars:



24 Jul 24

An overview of the VISTA FS-X platform for food security analysis. This session will introduce the DAMA module, offering cloud-based access to Earth Observation data and tools, and demonstrate the SeR module for managing data processing jobs through the DPaaS framework. Ideal for those looking to improve food security practices with advanced EO technology.



17 Jul 24

The session explored Polar TEP's capabilities, highlighting its integration of MLflow for managing machine learning workflows and its custom Jupyter Notebook environment for interactive teaching. Real-world use cases in both areas were also presented.



3 Jul 24

The session introduced Sentinel Hub APIs from the Copernicus Data and Services Ecosystem (CDSE), covering key functionalities of the Processing, Catalog, and Statistical APIs. Practical demonstrations using Jupyter Notebooks and the Request Builder app showed how to integrate these APIs into workflows for scaling data analysis across large areas.
